INTENTION TO PUBLISH INVITATION POPD-611614

Public Power Corporation S.A. (hereinafter PPC or the Company), 30 Chalkokondyli Street, 104 32 Athens, intends to publish the Electronic Selection Procedure POPD-611614 with subject: "Supply of 0.5–1.0% Sulfur Heavy Fuel Oil to PPC for the period up to 28-Feb-2027 and for the signing of a Master Sales Agreement between PPC and interested parties for the supply of 0.5–1.0% Sulfur Heavy Fuel Oil to PPC for the years 2026–2028".

The electronic procedure will be carried out using the "SAP Ariba" platform of PPC's Electronic Contracts System (hereinafter the System).

In order to secure the possibility of participation, it is a prerequisite for interested parties to register and initiate the certification process at the PPC Supplier Registry, under the procurement category code:

L1: Chemical, Building / Construction Materials & Derivatives → L2: Fuels (2112)

After successful initiation of the certification process, they will receive, at the email address they have defined in the "SAP Ariba Network" during registration, the link to the Invitation in order to submit an offer. A prerequisite for signing the Contract is the successful completion of the certification process by the preferred Bidder.

Registration does not entail any cost for interested parties.

Important Note: Participation in the tender for the supply of 0.5–1.0% Sulfur Heavy Fuel Oil to PPC for the period up to 28-Feb-2027 is open only to interested parties that have submitted documents for the HFO business, under L2 2112 Category. Interested parties that have submitted documents only for the Diesel business are not to participate in POPD-611614 and any such bid will be disregarded.
